Glan-Llyn: December 8th - 10th 2017

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am organising a residential trip for year ten pupils to Glan Llyn from 8th-10th December 2017. Glan Llyn is an Urdd Centre situated in Bala, North Wales. Please visit this link for further information:

Below is a summary of the proposed itinerary;

Friday 8th December: Pupils will depart school at approximately 08.00, and travel to Glan-Llyn. The journey will take approximately three and a half hours. Upon arrival at Glan-Llyn, pupils will be shown to their rooms and have lunch. They will take part in some activities during the afternoon followed by an evening programme of entertainment, including their evening meal.

Saturday 9th January: Pupils will undertake a bespoke programme incorporating a variety of activities such as climbing, canoeing, bowling, high ropes and more! A detailed programme of events will be provided nearer the time. Pupils will have breakfast, lunch, dinner and supper provided.

Sunday 10th January: Pupils will undertake some activities in the morning, before having lunch, then heading back to Eastern High School for around 18.00 (TBC).

I am also looking to potentially visit Bounce Below and/or Zipworld with pupils, which would incur additional costs, but these would be **optional** for pupils.

There may be some amendments to the above itinerary, which we will inform you of prior to the trip. Further details will be provided following receipt of deposit.

The purpose of the trip is to provide a chance for pupils to use their language skills authentically, whilst enhancing their Welsh culture in a beautiful part of Wales.

I have enclosed an 'Information for Parents' sheet provided by Glan Llyn, in addition to a health certificate which you will need to complete and return to myself with the attached consent slip.

The total cost of the trip will be £125, including;

- All travel via coach.
- 2 nights' accommodation.
- All activities and equipment across the three days
- All meals.

Eastern High is moving towards being a cashless school. With this in mind, payments for the trip to Glan Llyn can be made online using ParentPay. If you have NOT signed into ParentPay previously and your child is going on the trip, login details will be sent to you separately. Using ParentPay allows you to make a one-off payment or spread the payments out making it easier for families to budget. We will notify parents once the trip is live on ParentPay to enable you to start making payments.

A proposed payment plan is as follows;

Friday 6th October 2017: Non-refundable deposit of £45

Friday 3rd November 2017: £40 payment

Friday 1st December 2017: £40 payment

Balance should be paid in full by December 1st 2017.

Deposits and final balance payments must be paid by the designated dates; there is a minimum payment amount of £10 on Parent Pay.

If you would like your child to go on the trip please complete the enclosed consent slip and medical certificate and return to Miss Rees by Friday 29th September. Priority will be given to pupils who assist with Eisteddfod/Urdd events.
