Llangrannog - January 19th - 21st 2018

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am organising a trip for year seven and eight pupils to Llangrannog from 19th - 21st January 2018. Llangrannog is an Urdd Centre situated in Cardigan Bay, West Wales. Please visit this link for further information:

Below is a summary of the proposed itinerary;

Friday 19th January: Pupils attend lessons 1-3 as normal, but will be asked to bring their luggage to school with them. Pupils will be required to bring a packed lunch, which they will eat before boarding the coach. If pupils are in receipt of school lunches, the canteen will provide a packed lunch. We will then be departing school at approximately 13.00. Upon arrival at Llangrannog, pupils will be shown to their rooms and commence an evening programme of entertainment, including their evening meal.

Saturday 20th January: Pupils will undertake a bespoke programme incorporating a variety of activities such as skiing, tobogganing, archery, high ropes and more! A detailed programme of events will be provided nearer the time. Pupils will have breakfast, lunch, dinner and supper provided. During the evening, pupils will take part in activities and have a party as part of their celebrations.

Sunday 21st January: Pupils will undertake some activities in the morning, before having lunch then heading back to Eastern High School for around 18.00 (TBC).

There may be some amendments to the above itinerary, which we will inform you of prior to the trip. Further details will be provided following receipt of deposit.

The purpose of the trip is to provide a chance for pupils to use their language skills authentically, whilst enhancing their Welsh culture in a beautiful part of Wales.

I have enclosed an 'Information for Parents' sheet provided by Llangrannog, in addition to a health certificate which you will need to complete and return to myself with the attached consent slip.

The total cost of the trip will be £160, including;

- All travel via coach.
- 2 nights accommodation.
- All activities and equipment across the three days
- All meals.

Eastern High is moving towards being a cashless school. With this in mind, payments for the trip to Llangrannog can be made online using ParentPay. If you have NOT signed into ParentPay previously and your child is going on the trip, login details will be sent to you separately. Using ParentPay allows you to make a one-off payment or spread the payments out making it easier for families to budget. We will notify parents once the trip is live on ParentPay to enable you to start making payments.

A proposed payment plan is as follows;

Friday 6th October 2017: Non-refundable deposit of £40

Monday 6th November 2017: £40 payment

Friday 1st December 2017: £40 payment

Friday 12th January 2018: £40 payment

Balance should be paid in full by January 12th 2018.

Deposits and final balance payments must be paid by the designated dates; there is a minimum payment amount of £10 on Parent Pay.

If you would like your child to go on the trip please complete the enclosed consent slip and medical certificate and return to Miss Rees by Friday 29th September. Priority will be given to pupils who assist with Eisteddfod/Urdd events.
