### Llangrannog – February 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am organising a trip for year seven pupils to Llangrannog from 1<sup>st</sup>- 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2019. Llangrannog is an Urdd Centre situated in Cardigan Bay, West Wales. Please visit this link for further information:

Below is a summary of the proposed itinerary;

Friday 1<sup>st</sup> February: Pupils attend lessons 1-3 as normal, but will be asked to bring their luggage to school with them. Pupils will then have time to get lunch before boarding the coach and departing school at approximately 13.00. Upon arrival at Llangrannog, pupils will be shown to their rooms and commence an evening programme of entertainment, including their evening meal.

Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> February : Pupils will undertake a bespoke programme incorporating a variety of activities such as skiing, tobogganing, archery, high ropes and more! A detailed programme of events will be provided nearer the time. Pupils will have breakfast, lunch, dinner and supper provided. During the evening, pupils will take part in activities and have a party as part of their celebrations.

Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> February : Pupils will undertake some activities in the morning, before having lunch then heading back to Eastern High School for around 18.00 (TBC).

*There may be some amendments to the above itinerary, which we will inform you of prior to the trip. Further details will be provided following receipt of deposit.*

The purpose of the trip is to provide a chance for pupils to use their language skills authentically, whilst enhancing their Welsh culture in a beautiful part of Wales.

The total cost of the trip will be £160, including;

- All travel via coach.
- 2 nights accommodation.
- All activities and equipment across the three days
- All meals.
- Insurance on behalf of the Urdd.

A deposit of £60 will be required by Friday 2nd November 2019 to secure your child's place. You will then be required to follow the proposed payment plan below;

Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> November: Non-refundable deposit of £60

Friday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2018: £50 payment

Friday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2019: £50 payment

As we are a cash less school, all payments must be made online via Parent Pay. If you have misplaced your login details, please contact the school office.

If at any point you are experiencing difficulties with this payment plan please contact Miss Cowan, as the school may be able to offer you some assistance, following a meeting of our School Fund Committee and subject to set criteria within our Charging Policy.

If you would like your child to go on the trip please complete the consent slip, and return, to Miss S Morgan by Friday 26th October (the following week is half term, but deposits can still be paid via ParentPay). Priority will be given to those who regularly attend Welsh department activities and assist in Eisteddfod/Urdd events.
