## Llangrannog - January 19<sup>th</sup> - 21<sup>st</sup> 2018

Dear Parent/Carer,

Happy New Year! The Llangrannog trip is fast approaching, so here are some final details:

Friday 19<sup>th</sup> January: Pupils will attend lessons 1-3 as normal, but must bring their luggage to school with them. **Pupils must wear school uniform and will be given an opportunity to change prior to boarding the coach.** Pupils will be required to bring a packed lunch, which they will eat at school; they will only have access to the canteen at breaktime, not lunchtime. If pupils are in receipt of school lunches, the canteen will provide a packed lunch; if this is the case, please tick the relevant box on the attached form. We will be departing school at approximately 13.15. Upon arrival at Llangrannog, pupils will be shown to their rooms and commence an evening programme of entertainment, including their evening meal.

Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> January: Pupils will undertake a bespoke programme incorporating a variety of activities such as skiing, tobogganing, archery, high ropes and more! Pupils will have breakfast, lunch, dinner and supper provided. During the evening, pupils will take part in activities and have a party as part of their celebrations.

Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> January: Pupils will undertake some activities in the morning, before having lunch, then will make the return journey to school. We are expecting to be back at school by 4pm and will inform you if this changes, so it is essential the contact numbers provided are accurate. Please also follow @EHCymraeg on Twitter for updates.

All food and drink will be provided when at Llangrannog, but if your child wishes to bring some money for the snack shop or to purchase any merchandise, I recommend they bring no more than £5.

I have enclosed another copy of the 'Information for Parents' sheet provided by Llangrannog, which includes a list of items pupils are required to bring. Please contact me if there are any issues with any of the listed items. Please could you also complete the attached health certificate, even if your child has already returned theirs; this ensures information is fully updated.

A reminder that all payments should have been made by Friday 12th January, via ParentPay where possible. Again, if there are any queries about payment or indeed any further questions, please contact me.
